



MSA TRAVEL AWARD APPLICATION for iEESEP2019 is now open!

In order to assist MSA members (this time is open only to HDR students) to attend the 2nd International Conference on Energy-Efficient Separation (iEESEP2019) in Melbourne, Australia on 27-30 November 2019, **the MSA will sponsor three travel awards to fully support the conference registration costs (A\$400 for HDR students)**. The MSA executive will directly pay the registration costs of the award recipients to the iEESEP2019 organizing committee. The award winners will be announced to all MSA members.

Eligibility

- Must be a current member (HDR student) of the MSA
- Must have their abstract accepted and be the presenting author of an oral or poster presentation at the conference
- Must not have previously won a travel grant from MSA during the calendar year (January-December)

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be selected by a panel of judges according to their track record relative to opportunity, the quality of abstract and significance of research, justification of eligibility and the need for financial assistance.

Travel Funding use – What the MSA grant support program is for?

This travel award is provided specifically for the sponsorship of **iEESEP2019 conference registration**.

How to apply?

The application form (click to download) must be submitted via email to the MSA Travel Funding Committee (funding@membrane-australasia.org) with the subject line: “**iEESEP2019 travel award application**” at the announced deadline. The outcome of the application will be announced within 6 weeks after the deadline.

MSA travel award application submission deadline: 31 August 2019

Conditions

To qualify for this travel funding program, the awardee has to meet the following terms and conditions:

- **Reporting** – write a short article as a contribution to the MSA Newsletter, highlighting relevant points of interest to MSA members (can be about the conference or other member-related topics);
- **Acknowledgment** – the MSA (including the logo) must be acknowledged for providing financial support in the presentation materials.
